








FREELAND KIDS ZONE

Hello and welcome to Freeland Church's 2nd edition of Kids Zone. I hope you enjoy, exploring together, the Sermon on the Mount. Let us start with The Beatitudes.

BIBLE STORY TIME

		<p>In Matthew 5:1-12, Jesus makes ten statements. All except one start with the word "blessed." The word blessed means more than happy. Life doesn't always go our way, but we can be full of joy even if things aren't perfect.</p>
1		<p>"Blessed are those who are poor in spirit for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Being poor in spirit means that we are humble. Realizing our own sin and our spiritual emptiness and poverty makes us see that we really need God.</p>
2		<p>"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." Mourning is when we're really sad. God promises to make us feel better. He calms us with his Word, through his people and prayer. Heaven will be the ultimate comfort.</p>
3		<p>"Blessed are the meek for they shall inherit the earth." Being meek is being patient, not easily angered and not thinking of yourself too highly. Meekness brings what power moves cannot bring!</p>
4		<p>"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled." Humans have no righteousness of our own. When we realize that we're starving for righteousness, we should ask Christ, and He will fill us up with it.</p>
5		<p>"Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy." To have mercy is to be loving and kind to others-- even those you don't like. Mercy comes back to you. God and people will repay all the mercy you spend.</p>
6		<p>"Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God." Being pure is being clean. If we keep our mind, thoughts and decisions clean, then God says we'll understand and "see" Him more.</p>
7		<p>"Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God." When you are truly part of God's family, you start to be more like Him. Since Jesus is the Prince of Peace, we should be peaceful, too.</p>
8		<p>"Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Persecution can be something as simple as being ignored or something as serious as being put to death but, the kingdom of heaven is waiting for us!</p>
9		<p>Jesus says to rejoice and be glad because we will receive great treasures in heaven. The beatitudes are impossible to do without God's help. So ask Him for His help each morning!</p>

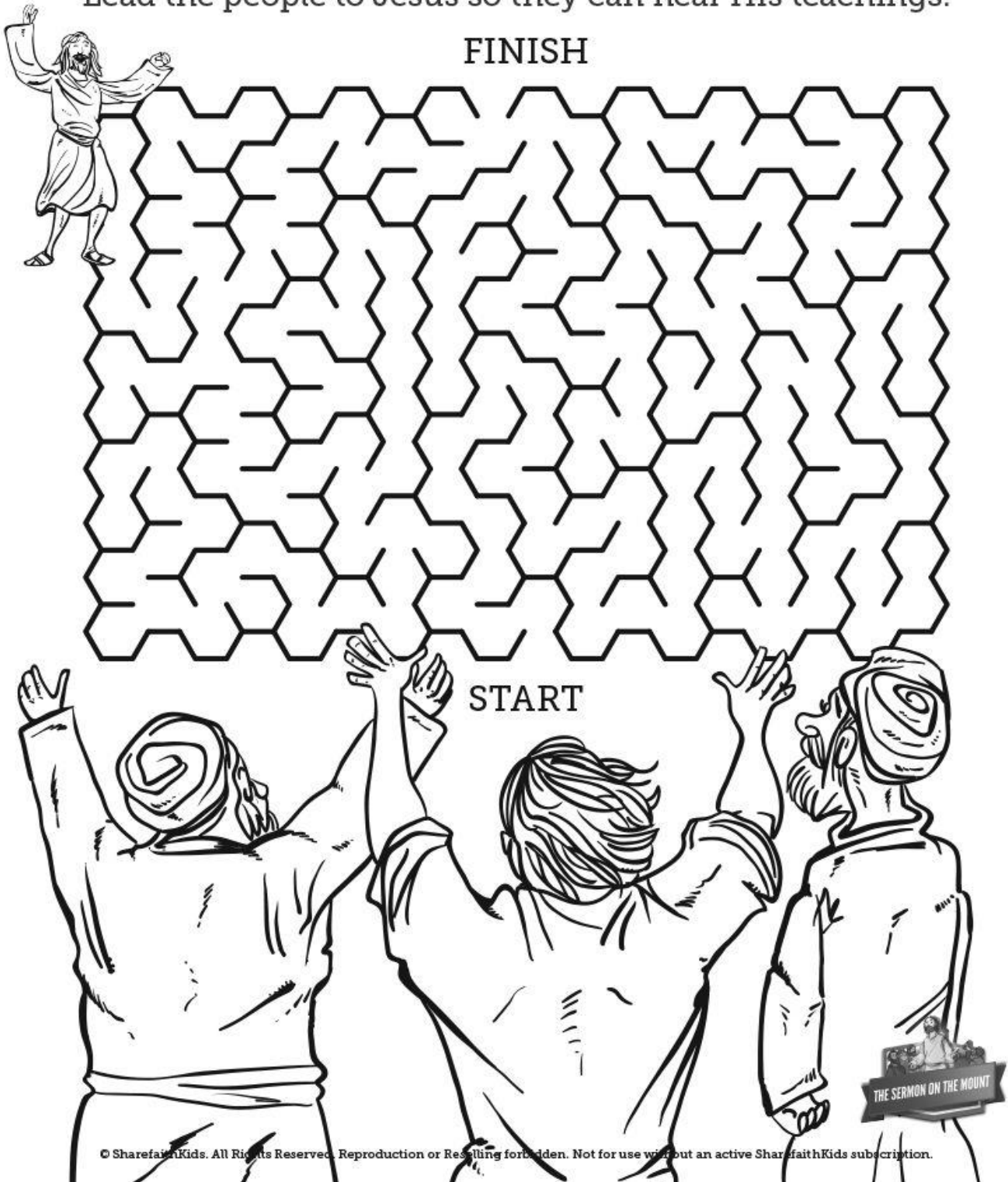
